



SPORTSPICK ENGLISH PREMIER LEAGUE 2011 / 2012

Key Time Frames

7 th August 2011	Round 1 open for tipping
13 th August 2011	Round 1 commences
18 th December 2011	EPL One 1 st Half Competition concludes
14 th January 2012	EPL Two 2 nd Half Competition commences
14 th May 2012	EPL 2011/12 Competition concludes

Selections for Home & Away Games

Entrants will make one (1) selection from the matches to be tipped on.

A selection can be one of the following:

- Home Team to WIN the match
- Away Team to WIN the match
- Drawn match

A correct selection will be awarded with ONE Point towards the entrant's tipping competition score.

Points will accumulate for the season duration to determine the winner. The person with the most points will be declared the Winner.

Selecting the "Joker"

Each round the entrant can allocate "The Joker" for one selection. If that selection is correct then the entrant accrues double points for that match (2 points).

Competition Prizes - Optional Local Venue Prizes

Venues will set, collect and manage their own entry fees and prize pools if they decide to conduct an 'in-house' local venue competition. Note: Promotions run by individual venues may require authorisation by the respective State Regulatory Authorities.

Competition Prizes – Sportspick 'All Venues' National Prize

End of Season Competition: Starts: August 13th, 2011 Finishes: 14th May, 2012

The entrant that accrues the most points over the competition will be declared the Winner. In the event of a tie the prizes will be divided equally.

1st Prize: \$2,000 2nd Prize: \$600 3rd Prize: \$400

Sportspick "EPL One" 1st Half Competition (Rounds 1-16)

Starts: August 13th, 2011 Finishes: 18th December, 2011 after round 16 (TBC approx. 16 rounds – subject to final EPL fixture)

The entrant(s) that accumulate the most points over the 'EPL One' period (Sportspick rounds 1-16) will be declared the winner(s).

1st Prize \$500, 2nd Prize, \$300, 3rd Prize \$200

In the event of tied scores, the prize will be equally divided between winning entrants.

Sportspick "EPL Two" 2nd Half Competition (Rounds 17-32)

Starts: 14th January 2012 (TBC approx date) Finishes: 14th May, 2012 after round 32 (TBC approx. 16 rounds – subject to final EPL fixture)

The entrant(s) that accumulate the most points over the 'EPL Two' period (Sportspick rounds 17-32) will be declared the winner(s).

1st Prize \$500, 2nd Prize, \$300, 3rd Prize \$200

In the event of tied scores, the prize will be equally divided between winning entrants.

Competition Rules

- Tipping for all rounds will be conducted on EPL games determined by Sportspick. i.e. Not all matches scheduled by the EPL will necessarily be included in a competition round. Matches scheduled for play on Saturday, Sunday, Monday (UK time) will be included. The matches selected for any particular round are entirely at the discretion of Sportspick.
- There will be **NO** tipping on mid-week matches initially scheduled as 'midweek' in the EPL fixture.
- Tips placed on matches that are either postponed and/or rescheduled for a later date will be processed after the completion of the postponed/rescheduled match. A postponed/rescheduled match will count towards a member's score for the purposes of the competition.
- If you do not make selections for a round you will be given the "Default Tips".
- "Default Tips" will be the Away teams to a maximum of 5 points. The default joker section will be the home team to win for the last named match of the round. If a joker selection is made on a postponed match then the default joker will apply.
- You can change both your Home & Away and Joker selections but must re-select all remaining matches for the round.
- Entrants must register with the venue to participate and the Sportspick Captain at the venue must add participants to the competition.
- There will be no tipping on matches scheduled between December 19th 2011 and January 13th 2012 (Sportspick EPL mid-competition break)
- Tipping for each round will close at midnight Saturday AEST.
